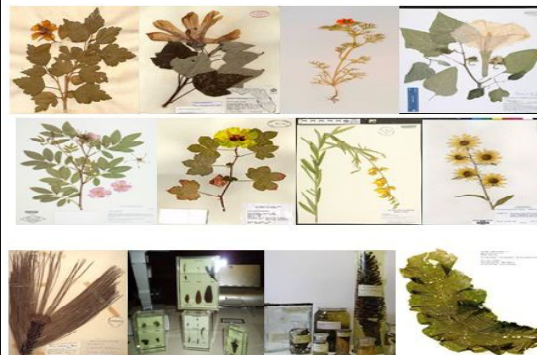

Faculty members published books and papers in national and international journals. The department maintains "Diamond jubilee herbal garden" in the campus.

The herbarium in the department has collection of locally available medicinal herbs listing out their medicinal values. It also has preserved and rare specimen as museum.



Department of Zoology

The Research Department of Zoology was started in the year 1960 at undergraduate level and was elevated to research level in 2013. The department is dynamic with reputation in academic excellence and innovations with well equipped laboratories. The faculty members are actively engaged in research activities, receiving grants from various funding agencies - UGC, DBT and DST for major and minor research projects. The faculty members participated and presented their findings in many international forums.

Museum of our department has unique and well preserved animal collections of common, rare, endangered and threatened species. It has more than 300 specimens, which are exclusively collected by our students. It also has the credit of having rare fossil specimens, skeleton of various animals and different stages of foetus.
