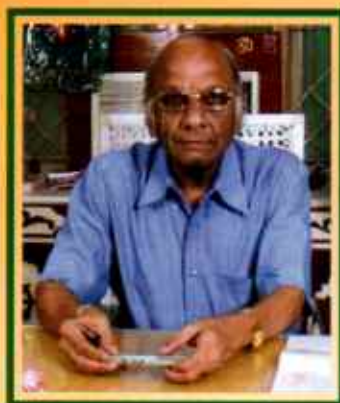

The goal of education is the advancement of knowledge and the dissemination of truth. The legacy of our institution dates back to the historic year of 1951 when our revered founder **Padmabhushan Sri. N. Ramaswami Ayyar** established this temple of learning with the noble cause of enlightening and empowering women through education. Though it had a humble inception of 11 students under a thatched roof, it has become an institution of excellence with nearly 4200 students.

This academic year the college was bestowed with five B.Voc. programmes (*Horticultural Science, Apparels Made ups-Home Furnishings, Beauty and Wellness - alternate Therapy Yoga, Food Processing and Electronics circuit designer and Electrician*) under the National Skill Qualification Framework. Under the Skill Sector Council of India, the "*Sericulture – Community College scheme*" has been extended up to 2018-2019. The Tamil Nadu Forest Plantation Corporation Limited (TAFCON) has sanctioned an amount of Rs.2 lakhs for the execution of the eco-green initiative programme *Green Dream through Neem*. The aim of the project is to promote the planting of neem trees in villages.

I feel proud to state that our college being a pioneer institution has adopted five villages in collaboration with 'Gramalaya', as we believe that 'service to God is serve to people'.

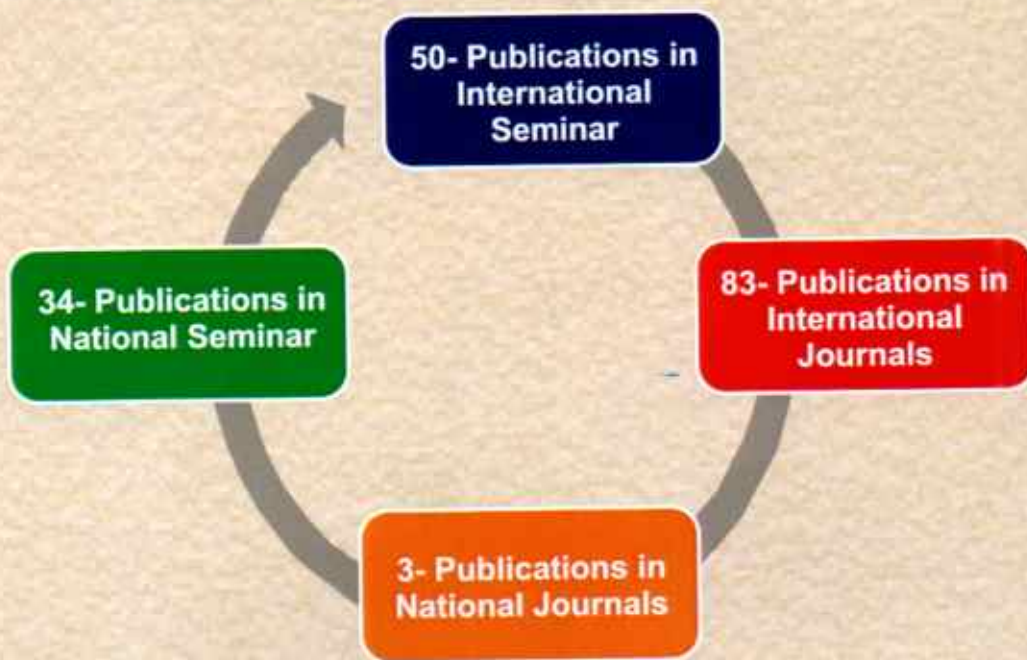

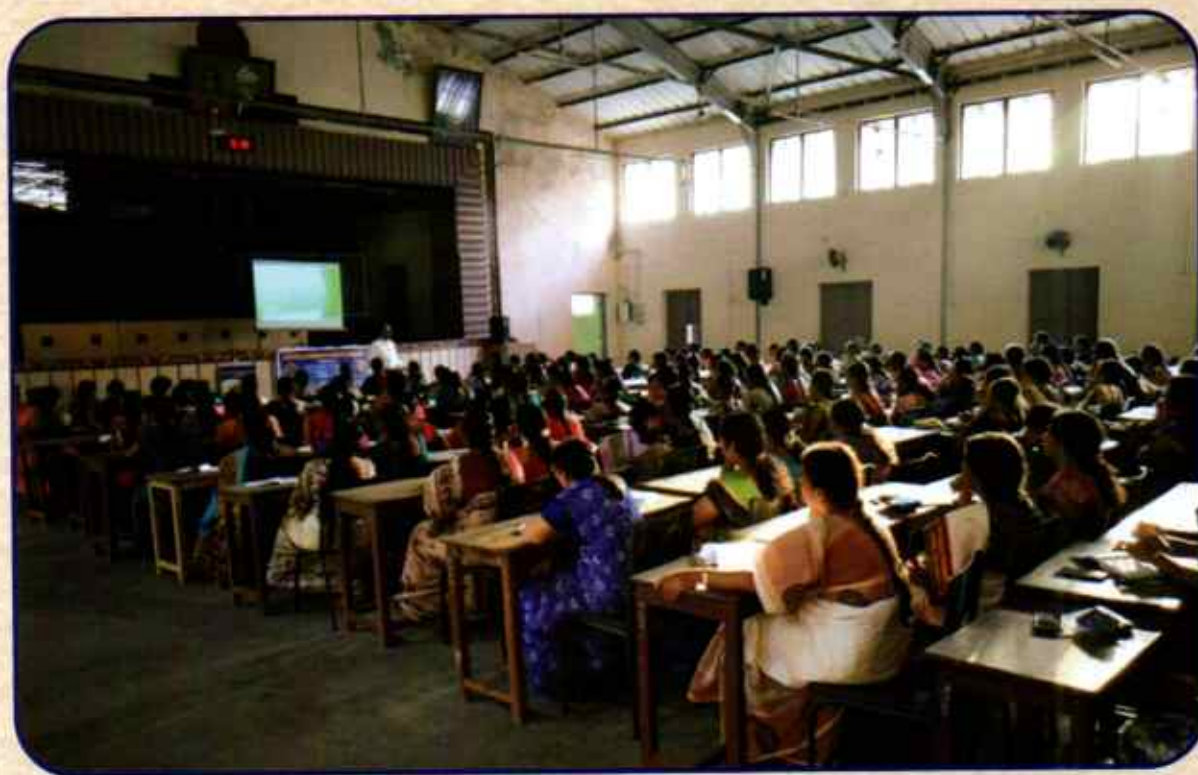

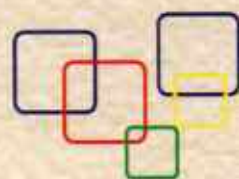
