Award Categories

Eligibility Criteria

- Must be a woman with a proven track record of public service individuals from Tiruchirappalli District alone are eligible
- Must be a woman actively engaged in grassroots-level service, working selflessly for the welfare of communities
- Must have a minimum of 5 years of experience in their respective field Contributions should have measurable positive impacts on society
- The nominee should uphold ethical values and integrity

Nomination Process

- **Submission:** Nominees must submit a detailed Profile including Personal/Organisation details, Description of achievements and supporting documents such as testimonials, news articles or project reports
- **Self-nominations and third-party nominations are accepted**
- **Deadline:** Details must be submitted on or before 15.02.2026
- **Review:** A jury panel will evaluate nominations based on impact, sustainability and innovation
- **Shortlisting:** Finalists will be announced during the first week of March- 2026
- **Winners will receive a trophy and citation on 07.03.2026**

EVALUATION CRITERIA

- **Impact** : Demonstrated positive change in society
- **Innovation** : Unique and sustainable solutions
- **Commitment** : Long-term dedication to public service
- **Scalability** : Potential to inspire and replicate the initiative

- Nominees should have made a meaningful impact on patient care, public health or health awareness.
- Contributions may include clinical service, community health initiatives, research or health education.
- Selection will consider commitment, leadership, compassion and professional ethics.

● SRC VISIONARY WOMAN AWARD FOR ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION

- The award recognises woman who have demonstrated visionary leadership and commitment to environmental conservation.
- Nominees should have made a significant and measurable impact in protecting or improving the environment.
- Contributions may include work in conservation, sustainability, climate action, biodiversity or environmental awareness.
- Selection will be based on innovation, long-term impact and dedication to ecological responsibility
