CALL FOR PAPERS

Organizers of the International Conference on Sustainability in Multidisciplinary Science Research invite researchers, academicians, scientists, and industry professionals to submit full papers for online presentations.

Submission Guidelines

A typical structure includes an abstract (250 words maximum). General guidelines for submitting a full-length article to an international conference on sustainability in multidisciplinary science research are as follows:

Introduction, literature review, methodology, results, discussion, conclusion and references. APA referencing is often required with specific guidelines for in-text citations and references. The length and format of full-length articles should be between 7,000 and 8,000 words, including tables, figures, and references. Submissions should be formatted in A4 size with specified margins (usually one inch on all sides). It is recommended that the text be double-spaced, using Times New Roman font at size 12 for the body text, and size 14 for headings if necessary.

Originality and Plagiarism Check

Papers must be original, not submitted elsewhere, and plagiarism-free with a similarity index below 10%.

Submission Process

Submissions made via email to <u>icsmsr2025@gmail.com</u> with documents submitted in Word format. The manuscript files are subjected to a double-blind peer review process, so all identifying information should be removed.

Review and Publication

All accepted papers will be published in a e-book entitled "International Conference on Sustainability in Multidisciplinary Science Research" with ISBN. In addition, selected papers may also qualify for publication in Web of Science / Scopus / UGC CARE listed journals after substantial revisions to avoid plagiarism and to maintain the academic standards of the publishers.
